March 23, 2019

WHEREAS, the United States Congress and President of the United States passed authorization for a CMU Check-off program; and

WHEREAS, the U. S. Department of Commerce will be developing an order that will outline a referendum likely to be held in late 2019 that will ask the CMU producer members to authorize a CMU Check-off program; therefore

Be it resolved, that the North Carolina Masonry Contractors Association:

1. Urges all CMU producers to support the referendum
2. Urges CMU producers to reach out to other producers to support the referendum
3. Urges members of the North Carolina Masonry Contractors Association to support the referendum

The membership of the North Carolina Masonry Contractors Association voted unanimously to support this referendum at the March 23, 2019 Annual Business Meeting of the Association held at the Marriott in Charleston, South Carolina.
